

Registration Information for Programs Offered by the Murrysville (MOM) Department of Recreation

The following information and procedures will help to facilitate your registration for programs offered by the Municipality of Murrysville Recreation Department.

Complete all required information as indicated on the registration form and mail or deliver the form to:

Register early. Registrations will be placed in the order they are received. Registrations will not be accepted at the class site.

Don't let a class be cancelled due to an appearance of a lack of interest because everyone waited until the last minute.

For mail in registrations, please use one registration form for each individual registrant. You may register each person for more than one class on the same form.

Payment. Pay fee in person or by mail along with form to the address above by checks or money order must be made payable to MOM. For e-checks and credit cards, register on-line at www.murrysvillegov.org. A single payment may be made for all family members.

Non-Resident Registration.

All persons living in the Franklin Regional School District pay resident fees.

Non-residents are required to add a \$5.00 surcharge for each class when registering.

Refund Policy. There will be no refunds for personal reasons. A registrant cannot transfer his/her right to attend a program to another person.

Attendance. Attend the first class as scheduled. **NOTIFICATIONS WILL BE MADE ONLY IF A CLASS IS FILLED, POSTPONED OR CANCELED.**

Class Cancellations. The Recreation Department reserves the right to cancel, postpone or reschedule any class that does not meet the minimum number of class participants. Every effort will be made to reschedule sessions due to unanticipated events or instructor illness. Rescheduling is not guaranteed.

Cancellations:

Cancellations will be announced at 724-327-2100, X562. Check with business locales regarding their policies.

Insurance. The municipality does not carry insurance to cover hospitalization or medical costs for persons injured during the course of participating in or viewing of any of MOM's programs or events. All participants enter programs at their own risk.

Accessibility. People with disabilities who require special accommodations that are registering for classes must contact the recreation office prior to the start of class so appropriate preparations can be made.
