These positions report directly to the Public Works Foremen (Roads and/or Parks) and/or the Director of Engineering, Public Works, and Parks, and/or the Facilities Custodian. However, the Summer Aide normally works in conjunction with an Equipment Operator, Truck Driver, and/or Laborer.

Work Includes:

- ✓ Work period is from March 15 to October 1.
- ✓ Primary responsibilities will be maintenance of playing fields, park areas, and road projects.
- ✓ Ability to undertake heavy physical labor, such as shoveling asphalt or stone, climbing into ditches or equipment, and lifting 100 pounds of sacked materials.

Required qualifications include:

- ✓ Must be 18 years of age or older.
- ✓ Possession of a valid PA driver's license and a good driving record (subject to verification by Murrysville), ability to drive a pickup or one-ton truck with standard transmission.
