

**MUNICIPALITY OF MURRYSVILLE
WESTMORELAND COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE No. 608-02

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING ROADS LOCATED IN THE HERITAGE ESTATES PLAN – PHASE 2 SITUATED IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF MURRYSVILLE, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AS PART OF THE PUBLIC HIGHWAY SYSTEM OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF MURRYSVILLE, COUNTY OF WESTMORELAND, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA.

WHEREAS, by an Act of the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania P.L. 62, supplements and amendments thereto, and the Home Rule Charter of the Municipality of Murrysville, Article V, Section 507, subparagraph 4:

“Council shall, when appropriate, receive and accept all gifts or donations of real or personal property or interest therein in the name of the municipality.”

AND WHEREAS, the subdivision of Heritage Estates – Phase 2 includes streets known as Harvest Drive being 1,754.648 feet in length along the centerline of the right-of-way and extending from the centerline of Iris Court to the intersection of Barberry Court and Barberry Court being 1,078.292 feet in length along the centerline of the right-of-way from the intersection with Harvest Drive and extending to a cul-de-sac. And said roadways and right-of-ways have been previously dedicated to public use of the owners thereof, as evidenced by the Plan of Lots which is now recorded in the Recorder’s Office in and for the County of Westmoreland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. (Instr: 200110120056112, T20010053912, dated 10/12/01).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED AND IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED, AND enacted by the Council of the Municipality of Murrysville, County of Westmoreland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, in accordance with the Act of Assembly, herein above referenced to:

Those roadways known as Harvest Drive being 1,754.648 feet in length and Barberry Court being 1,078.292 feet in length all of which are within a minimum right-of-way width of 50 feet and being situated in the Heritage Estates Plan – Phase 2 as recorded by Instr: 200110120056112, T20010053912, dated 10/12/01, which is on file in the Murrysville Municipal Building and is hereby incorporated into this ordinance and made part thereof.

THE SAME BEING HEREBY ACCEPTED as part of the Public Highway System of the Municipality of Murrysville.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED that the Municipality of Murrysville accepts all of the storm sewers and easements associated with the above-described plan and roadways, excluding the lot (57,149 sf) that contains the stormwater pond as shown on the recorded plan.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED THAT THIS ORDINANCE be duly enacted upon the minutes of the Council and that a certified and attested copy thereof be filed with the Clerk of Courts of the Common Pleas, Criminal Division (Roads), County of Westmoreland, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, whereupon said Harvest Drive and Barberry Court become and are part of the Public Highway System of the Municipality of Murrysville.
