

Directions to Franklin Regional HS

From Murrysville and West

Take Route 22 East toward Murrysville. As you travel on Route 22, you will go through five traffic lights. As you enter Murrysville, you will come to a traffic light with Wendy's restaurant on your right. Make a left turn onto Old Rt. 22 (Old Wm. Penn Hwy.) Follow Old Wm. Penn Hwy. for approximately two miles. Turn left into the school complex at the digital activity sign. The High School is located at the top of the hill.

From Greensburg and East

Take Route 66 North. Turn Left onto Route 22 West toward Murrysville. Travel approximately 5 miles on Route 22 West through six traffic lights. After passing the West Penn Plaza (which will be on your right), you will turn right at the next light (Walnut Hollow Shopping Center on your left) onto Cline Hollow Road. You will see a Rite Aid store in front of you to the right at this light. At the 4-way stop, make a left onto Old William Penn Highway. Continue straight on Old William Penn Highway through the next light, crossing over School Road. You will see the school complex on your right. Turn right into the school complex at the digital activity sign. The High School is located at the top of the hill.

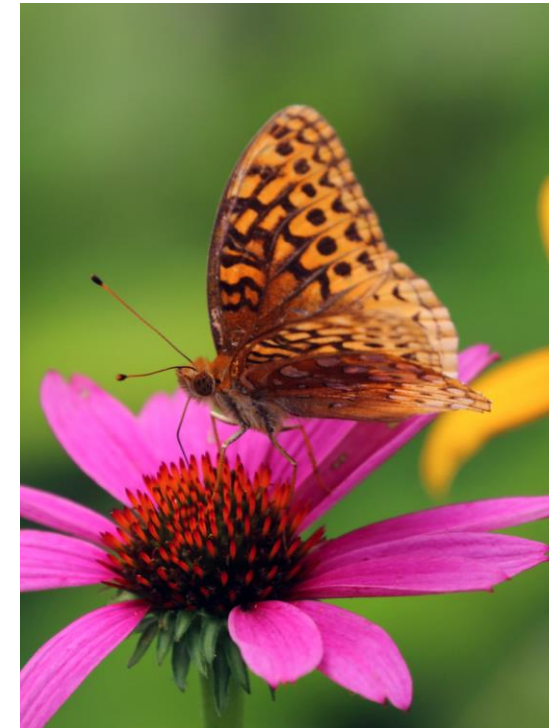
